What is High Country Harvest?

High Country Harvest is a regional event program that showcases the phenomenal food, wine and craft beer offering that the region is so renowned for. 2018 will mark the sixth year of the event.

High Country Harvest is made up of around 50 "Hero Events" supported by Harvest Menus and Autumn Warmers, Village Bonfires, Farmers Markets and other collaborative events.

What are the key objectives of High Country Harvest?

- Drive visitation and yield to generate tangible event outcomes such as visitation and event bookings, bed nights and yield in a period that is generally quiet in terms of visitation.
- Generate brand and product awareness to maximise exposure for the High Country and one of its key product pillars, with a view to positioning the region as the State's premier food and wine destination.
- Industry and product development to assist food, wine and craft beer businesses with developing new
 tourism experiences in a supportive environment, which are on-trend and have the potential to grow
 into a year-round offering, thereby strengthening the regional product.





How does High Country Harvest work?

You are invited to submit an event (Hero Event) either on your own or in collaboration with other businesses, that will take place between 4 and 20 May 2018. Tourism North East will curate the program and marketing of the program, however individual businesses will still need to undertake marketing to generate sales of tickets to their event.

What if I don't want to run an event?

If you don't want to run an event but would like to participate in the festival we invite you to enter a Harvest Menu or Autumn Warmer. This is a special dish or drink heroing the produce of the region and the season (Autumn). You offer this for the hours that suit you during the festival. This is free to participate in but you must provide details and an image to TNE to be a part of the program.

Who is able to participate?

Any business connected to Food, Wine and Craft beer in the High Country who has a current up to date ATDW listing is able to submit an expression of interest for an event. If you are not sure please give us a call.

How much does it cost?

Hero event fee is \$170 + gst if your event is ready to go by the 1st of December with ATDW event listing and eventbrite ticketing completed (workshops are offered to assist with this) or \$195 + gst if this is done later. Autumn Warmers, Harvest Menus and Bonfires list free if all details received before 1 December 2017 after this a \$40 late entry fee will apply.

Key Selection Criteria

- The event is uniquely created for the High Country harvest program
- The event organisers must have a current ATDW listing throughout the program
- The event must contribute to the objective of promoting the strength and diversity of the High Country's Food and Drink landscape.
- The event must acknowledge its connection to High Country Harvest (eg welcome speech, printed menu etc)
- The event falls within the High Country Harvest dates of 4 20 May 2018
- The event conforms with the centralised ticketing system used by Tourism North East.
- The event organiser is open to hosting media
- The event organiser commits to completing an ATDW event listing before December 1, 2017
